Needs for Paper Research: Now We All Need to Buy SurveNIRs

Abstract

Digitisation and the analyse of the health status of a paper document should be interconnected. In this article a so far only planned research project is outlined. The title of the suggested application proposal reads as follows: “Implementation of data gained by SurveNIR into the database consisting of digital images and library catalogue.”¹ It is desired that a programme/device interconnect and combine the data concerning the condition of a material (gained by a non-destructive survey), catalogue data and digitisation results on the one hand and an interface module to other usual catalogue systems on the other hand (or at least a definition on what such an interface module should be able to do).
